You can post Shrek pictures, user guides, internal company guidelines; you can edit your doc in drive - the published version will stay the same until you decide it's time to publish the changes. The document versioning is that much easier.

You can easily display this document on your website, communities, internal resources.

You can set it up so that the users can or cannot download it. All in all, ZuppDoc is a nice way of document distribution that makes versioning and PDF conversion easier - because it takes care of it for you.

One more important point is that the documents are stored outside of Salesforce - in the Salesforce instance they are represented as a record with a link to a document in it, thus saving you a lot of storage space. With some tweaking, you can also display this document in Salesforce for internal usage.
